BISU Application Guide for Beijing International Students Scholarship (Freshmen)

Beijing International Students Scholarship (Freshmen)

is provided by the People's Government of Beijing Municipality for outstanding international students who come to Beijing for their studies. It is aimed at developing high-level international student enrollment scale in Beijing's higher education institutions and promoting the overall level of internationalization of education in Beijing's universities.

I. Category

1. Applicants for master's degree: one academic year tuition fee reduction or exemption.

2. Applicants for bachelor's degree: one academic year tuition fee reduction or exemption.

3. Applicants for non-degree advanced study or long-term Chinese language program: one semester tuition fee reduction or exemption.

II. Qualifications

Outstanding international students who apply to study in BISU.

III. Requirements

1

1. Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens;

2. Applicants must be friendly to China and abide by the law and rules of Chinese government;

3. Applicants should have excellent academic performance and good health;

4. Applicants' academic qualifications and age requirements are as follows:

(1) Applicants for bachelor's degree must have at least a high school diploma and be generally no older than 30 years old; applicants for master's degree must be at least a bachelor's degree holder and generally no older than 35 years old.

(2) Those who apply for non-degree advanced study in related majors must have a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree or be in the second year of college or above, and they should generally not exceed 50 years old; applicants who apply for long-term language learning program should have a high school degree and above, and they should generally not exceed 60 years old.

IV. Application Materials

Related materials can be written either in Chinese or English. The submitted application documents will NOT be returned regardless of acceptance or denial:

1. Application Form for Beijing International Students Scholarship for International Students (Freshmen) (see Attachment 1);

2. Notarized highest academic qualification and academic transcripts;

3. For those who have been studying for more than 6 months (including 6 months) in China, a "Physical Examination Record for Foreigners" (printed by the Chinese health and quarantine authorities) is required;

4. Applicants for an academic degree or non-degree advanced study should provide a study plan (of no less than 400 words) or a research plan (of no less than 800 words);

5. Applicants under the age of 18 should submit relevant legal documents of their legal guardians in China.

V. Application Procedures

1. Please first complete the online application at <u>http://apply.bisu.edu.cn/</u>, choosing Local Government Scholarship, after which your online application form will be generated, and then mail the form to study@bisu.edu.cn

2. After receiving students' materials, BISU will review the application documents and conduct a merit-based selection featuring openness, fairness and impartiality. The final interpretation for the admission of students belongs to the International Admissions Office.

VI. Timeline

1. All application documents should be submitted online between March 1 and May 31, 2024.

2. Final Results: The final evaluation results shall be announced in July.
